Caltrans Seeks Public Feedback on Proposed Highway 16 Project

Plans Call for Safety Improvements in Esparto, Capay Areas

ESPARTO – Caltrans is hosting a community open house on Tuesday, June 5 to discuss plans for safety improvements on State Highway 16 in Esparto and the Capay area in Yolo County.

The event is scheduled from **5:30 to 7 p.m.** at the Boy Scout Meeting Hall, 17020 Yolo Avenue, Esparto. Community members can view project displays and review materials, including a draft environmental document. Caltrans staff members will be available to answer questions and receive comments from the public.

Caltrans is proposing a \$3.6 million project to improve motorist and pedestrian safety along portions of Highway 16 in Capay and Esparto. Plans include increasing and improving street lighting and making improvements to pedestrian crossings.
